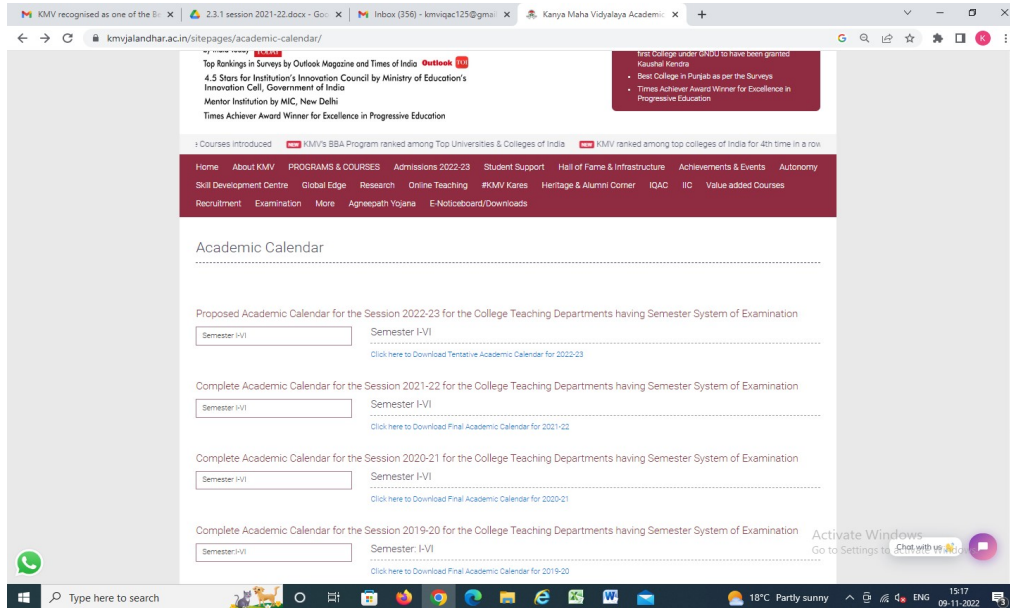



Two day **training programme** was organised on Public Financial Management System. The resource person for this training was Mr. S. Francis, Senior Accounts Officer, Ministry of Finance, and Government of India. He congratulated the college authorities for being the first college of North India to organise this workshop on PFMS. During the workshop, Mr Francis made very informative and interesting revelations about various aspects of PFMS like Classification of Schemes on PFMS Portal, PFMS based Fund Flow for GoI Schemes, PFMS Integration with various banks, NGOs, Standalone government systems and government treasury. He further explained that PFMS has integrated with almost 500 Nationalised Banks, Major Private Sector Banks, All Regional Rural Banks, Cooperative Banks and India Post. He presented flow charts depicting PFMS-CBS interface, Daily Transaction Data and Account Validation Response. He explained various payment modes for live transactions and Past Payments – for legacy entries and Implementation Methodologies like REAT, TSA and SNA. He explained in detail about the newly developed expenditure related software EAT and various fund management modules. He also highlighted various schemes used by Colleges and Universities.



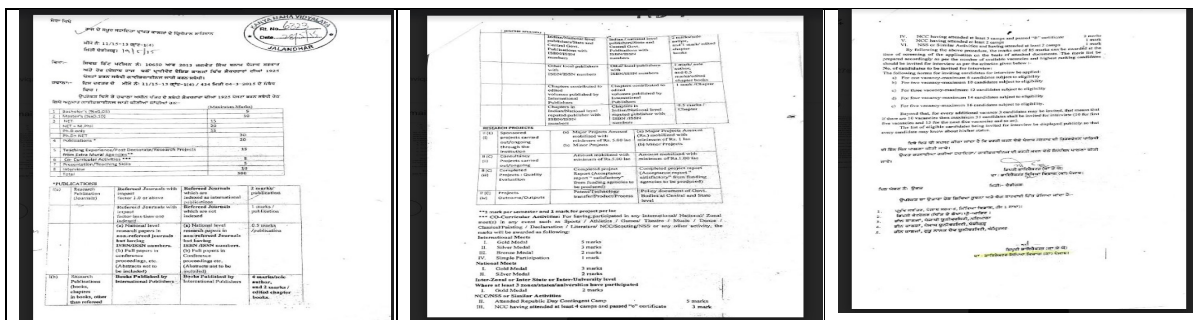
